TERMS: Exhibitors for The Courier-Mail The Sunday Mail Home Show 2012

1 **Offer to Exhibit** –Exhibitions and Events Australia (EEA) may at its sole discretion accept or reject the Application. EEA do not have to give any reason for its decision and shall not be liable for any loss or damage suffered by any person because of its decision.

2 **Acceptance** - If EEA accept the Application, it will post to the Exhibitor at the address on the application form an invoice which will specify the space, the amount of the fee, when the fee is payable and the period of the licence. The posting of the invoice will constitute the granting of a licence on the terms of this Agreement.

3 **Rejection** - If EEA reject the Application, it will send a notice by post to the Exhibitor at the address on the application form.

4 **Payment of Moneys** - The Exhibitor must pay the fee specified in the invoice within 7 days of the due date. This fee is non-refundable.

5 **Exhibition** - The Exhibitor must have its exhibition ready by the opening date of the Home Show. EEA reserve the right to change the dates and times of the show.

6 **Location** - EEA can at any time change the location and size of the space. The Exhibitor has no right to claim loss or damage because of any change.

7 **Obligation to Exhibit** -The Exhibitor must use the space for marketing, distribution and sale of the Exhibitor's products. EEA may prohibit the marketing sale or distribution of any product or material that it considers may be an annoyance, nuisance or offensive to others. The Exhibitor shall not allow any other person to exhibit in or occupy the space. The space can be used for the period specified by EEA.

8 **Cancellation/Default** - At any time and for any reason EEA and Queensland Newspapers Pty Ltd may cancel the Home Show and EEA may cancel this Agreement. The Exhibitor has no right to claim for any loss or damage because of any cancellation. In the event of cancellation of the Home Show any deposit or other moneys received by EEA from the Exhibitor shall be refunded to the Exhibitor. If the Exhibitor does not pay the fees or does not meet all the terms of this Agreement then EEA can terminate the Agreement. If EEA or Exhibitor terminates the Agreement prior to completion, EEA may do any or all of the following

(a) retain the fees paid; (b) recover from the Exhibitor as a liquidated debt the balance of fees payable under the Agreement but for the cancellation; (c) remove any property of the Exhibitor and store at the Exhibitor's cost; (d) recover from the Exhibitor as a liquidated debt any loss, damage or expense incurred by EEA as a result of the termination or default of the Exhibitor.

9 **Chattels** - The Exhibitor cannot bring any chattels onto the leased area without first giving to EEA a written list. The Exhibitor cannot remove any chattels from the leased areas without first obtaining EEA permission in the form of a door pass.

10 **Exhibitors** -Any exhibit and demonstration must be first approved by the EEA and the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland. An exhibit must not exceed 2.4 metres in height except against pavilion walls. Exhibits must be contained within the space and no parts shall overhang the aisles or neighbouring areas. All signage must be contained within the allocated space and not facing another exhibitor. Exhibits must accommodate viewers so as to avoid obstruction of public areas. Any exhibit or demonstration that does not have EEA and the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland approval or meet EEA and RNA standards may be removed by EEA at the cost of the Exhibitor and without prior notice.

11 **Use of Equipment** - No microphones, sound amplification or machinery can be used without the prior approval of EEA. EEA can at its discretion approve its use and upon such conditions as it may require. Use of equipment or machinery in contravention of this clause may be removed by EEA without notice to the Exhibitor and at the cost of the Exhibitor.

12 **Laws** -The Exhibitor will comply with all laws, rules and directions of any governmental authority and all lawful directions of the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland. The Exhibitor will act at all times to ensure the good health and safety of the public. Please refer to the Workplace, Health and Safety rules, regulations and issues in the Exhibitors Manual.

13 **Trade Promotions, Art Unions and Competitions** -Without limiting the general obligation of the Exhibitor to comply with all laws as provided in clause 12, the Exhibitor shall comply with all laws, regulations, rules and directions of any government authority relating to competitions, trade promotions and art unions,including the Charitable and Non-Profit Gaming Act 1999, Regulations and Rules (Old).

14 **Alcohol** - The Exhibitor shall not bring into the leased area or allow to be consumed in the space any alcohol or illegal substances.

15 **Maintenance** -The Exhibitor shall at its cost, at all times, keep its space and exhibits clean and in orderly condition. On the expiration or termination of this Agreement the Exhibitor must leave the space in a clean and orderly condition and remove all materials and chattels. The Exhibitor shall not damage any part of the leased area. The Exhibitor must not paint, glue or use non-removal adhesive tape or otherwise alter the floor, walls, ceiling and roofs. EEA may repair, at the cost of the Exhibitor, any damage to the leased area caused or contributed to by the Exhibitor.

16 **Exhibition Access** - The Exhibitor has a right to access and use of the space at such times and on such dates as EEA decide. Any access or use is on the terms of this Agreement. EEA shall issue passes to the Exhibitors and authorised personnel.

17 **Electricity** - The fee includes a charge for the lighting of the buildings and normal exhibits. The Exhibitor shall pay for all costs associated with the installation, use and removal of any electricity. All electrical installations must be done by a contractor appointed by EEA. EEA shall not be liable for any loss or damage caused by any break or interruption in the supply of electricity.

18 **No Representations or Warranties** -Except as in this Agreement and to the extent that same may not be excluded by statute, EEA make no representations or warranties in relation to the Home Show and is not the agent of and shall not be liable for any representations or warranties given by Queensland Newspapers Pty Ltd, the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland, and any official sponsors or suppliers and shall not be liable for any loss, damage, misfeasance and non-misfeasance caused or contributed to by the Queensland Newspapers Pty Ltd, Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland, and any official sponsors or suppliers.

19 **Indemnities** - Save and except in circumstances where such is attributable to the negligence or wilful act or default of EEA or Queensland Newspapers Pty Ltd or either of their employees and agents, neither EEA, its employees and agents nor Queensland Newspapers Pty Ltd, its employees and agents shall be liable for any death, injury, loss or damage, economic loss or indirect or consequential damage caused by, arising out of or with respect to the granting of this licence or use by the Exhibitor, its agents or employees, invitees, licensees, servants and visitors of the space or any exhibit or the use of services provided by EEA and its employees and agents. The Exhibitor shall indemnify and keep indemnified EEA in respect of any death, injury, loss or damage however occurring in connection with the use by any person of the space or any exhibit. The Exhibitor shall have (a) public liability insurance in respect of the space and exhibits thereon for a sum of not less than \$10 million for any one claim and (b) property insurance policy to cover loss or damage to any property of the Exhibitor or damage to adjoining or nearby space, exhibits or structures.

N.B. Point (a) of this term: EEA have retained the services of an insurance broker to provide Public Liability coverage, arranged with OBE.

20 **Floor Loadings** - No heavy vehicles shall be brought into the leased area without the prior consent of EEA. Heavy articles or vehicles are restricted to solid reinforced areas. If the Exhibitor causes any damage to the floor or grounds it shall reinstate the floor or damage to the grounds. EEA may, at its discretion, and at the cost of the Exhibitor, reinstate any damage.

21 **Fire Safety** - Materials used in exhibit construction or decoration must not be readily ignitable or be capable of emitting toxic fumes should ignition occur.

22 **Queensland Law** - This Agreement shall be subject to the laws of Queensland and any dispute arising out of this Agreement shall be heard by a Court of competent jurisdiction in Brisbane.

23 **Rules, Regulations and Orders** - EEA may make rules and give directions as it thinks fit for the proper conduct of the exhibition specified in this Agreement. The Exhibitor shall comply with any such rules and directions.

24. Definitions

'Agreement'	means these terms, the application form and the invoice.
'Application'	means the application by the Exhibitor to use space from EEA to exhibit at the Home Show. The application is constituted by a completed, signed application form.
'Exhibitor'	means the company/person named in the application form.
"Governmental authority"	means any government or any governmental or semi governmental entity, authority, agency, commission, corporation or body (including without limitation, those constituted or formed under any statute).
"leased area"	means the area leased by Queensland Newspapers Pty Ltd from Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland for the purpose of conducting a Home Show.
"EEA"	means Exhibitions and Events Australia Pty Ltd – the show organisers
"space"	means the part of the leased area used under licence by the Exhibitor from EEA.
